Cook County Pattern

Patterned lumber is largely associated with early American Décor but with modern technology, new patterns create modern finishing lumber. Most patterns are reversible providing a choice of pattern or surface finish in one panel. Patterned boards are inspected and graded on the pattern or face side, but the back face can add to the design (but can also lower the grade). There are many different patterns, and each pattern has a style and number. For example, Tongue and Groove, Beaded Ceiling, WP-4, and Car Siding are just a few patterns available.


